

# 1-37 Armor Deployment History

---

8 May 1941 – Pine Camp, New York Designated 37<sup>th</sup> Armored Regiment

10 September 1943 – Designated 37<sup>th</sup> Tank Battalion Camp Bowie, Brownwood Texas

29 December 1943 – 37<sup>th</sup> Tank Battalion sailed from the [Boston Port of Embarkation](#)

8 January 1944 – Arrival in England.

12 Jul 1944 – Unit arrived at Normandy Beach in France and battled all the way to Czechoslovakia in May 1945

1 May 1946 37th Tank Battalion relieved from assignment to the [4th Armored Division](#); concurrently converted and redesignated as the 37th Constabulary Squadron and assigned to the 3d Constabulary Regiment.

20 September 1947 Inactivated in Germany and relieved from assignment to the 3d Constabulary Regiment

15 June 1954 – Activated at Fort Hood, Texas

December 1957 – Fort Hood, Texas to McKee Barracks in Crailsheim Germany

July 1966 – From McKee Barracks in Crailsheim, Germany to Hindenburg Kaserne In Ansbach, Germany

August 1969 – From Hindenburg Kaserne in Ansbach, Germany to Bismark Kaserne In Katterbach, Germany

10 May 1971 – 1-37 Armor reassigned from 4AD to 1AD

May 1988 – From Bismarck Kaserne in Katterbach, Germany to Rose Barracks, Vilseck Germany until Feb 1996.

16 August 1991 – 1-37 Armor Reassigned from 1AD to 3ID. Redesignated 16 Feb 1996

17 February 1997 – From Rose Barracks to Ray Barrack, Friedberg, Germany until December 2007

July 2008 – Jan 2011 – Fort Bliss Texas

20 June 2015 – Present – Fort Bliss, Texas
